

Practitioner Registry Appeal for Career Path Level

You may appeal to the Practitioner Registry Review Committee if you feel the level that you were placed at is incorrect. The purpose of the appeal process is for college coursework only, appeals regarding years of experience in leu of college credit will not be considered.

If you wish to appeal, you must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Current on the Practitioner Registry
- 2. 1,000 hours working in an early childhood setting. Early childhood settings are programs offering services to young children and their families including administrative and teacher/caregiver roles, or programs that conduct training or education in early childhood.
- 3. College coursework or degree from regionally accredited colleges or universities. In order to count towards a level on the Career Path, college credits and degrees must be from a regionally accredited college or university. The US Department of Education manages a database for institutional accreditation, which can be found at www.ope.ed.gov/accreditation, There are six accrediting bodies, view the info sheet HERE.
